

KENTUCKY GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

PURSUANT TO KENTUCKY UNIFORM POWER OF ATTORNEY ACT (KRS § 457.010 ET SEQ.)

NOTICE: THE POWERS GRANTED UNDER THIS INSTRUMENT ARE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND SHALL NOT BE AFFECTED BY THE SUBSEQUENT DISABILITY OR INCAPACITY OF THE PRINCIPAL.

1. PRINCIPAL DESIGNATION: I, [PRINCIPAL NAME], residing at [Principal Address], Commonwealth of Kentucky, hereby appoint [AGENT NAME], residing at [Agent Address], as my Attorney-in-Fact (Agent).

2. SUCCESSOR AGENT: If my primary agent is unable or unwilling to act, I designate [SUCCESSOR AGENT NAME] as my successor attorney-in-fact.

3. GENERAL GRANT OF AUTHORITY: I grant my agent full power and authority to act on my behalf pursuant to KRS Chapter 457 with respect to: Real Property, Tangible Personal Property, Banking & Financial Accounts, Business Operations, Insurance & Annuities, Tax Matters, and Personal Maintenance.

4. DURABILITY: This power of attorney is durable and shall remain effective notwithstanding any subsequent mental or physical disability of the principal.

5. RECORDING FOR REAL ESTATE: Pursuant to Kentucky law, if this power of attorney is used to convey real property, it must be recorded in the County Clerk's office where the real estate is located.
